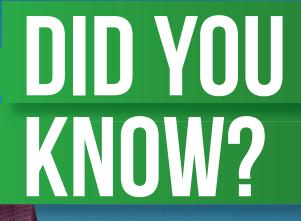


A speech-language pathologist is a university educated and licensed professional
